



Dermal Filler Treatment at PHI Clinic

What are dermal fillers and what are they used for?

As we grow older, the hyaluronic acid we once produced to provide volume to the face starts to diminish. Our skin becomes dry and facial volume decreases. Gravity pulls the skin down, resulting in folds and sagging.

At Phi Clinic we use JUVÉDERM® range of dermal fillers from Allergan, the world leaders of surgical and non-surgical aesthetic products. They create a natural, subtle effect to treat deep lines, wrinkles, volume loss, jawline slimming and non-surgical lifting. JUVÉDERM® dermal fillers are made from hyaluronic acid, which naturally occurs in our bodies, to return volume and moisture to the face and skin to give a plump, youthful and rejuvenated appearance.

At PHI, we use a new generation of dermal fillers: the Juvéderm range from Allergan, the world leaders of surgical and non-surgical aesthetic products. They create a natural, subtle effect and their advance products contain Lidocaine to help numb the treated area simultaneously during treatment. This has proven to improve patients' experience.

The most popular fillers we use are:

Volbella

Volbella is designed specifically for the lip and mouth area. The smooth gel is injected by the physician using an ultra-fine needle. It has been developed to give a soft, natural feel. The gel fills in lip lines and wrinkles and the hyaluronic acid within the product attracts and retains moisture, meaning results can last up to a year.

Voluma

Voluma is used to replenish lost skin volume, especially in cheek area, as it can enhance the overall shape of your face. The volumiser works to add support to the skin and enhance one's natural beauty.

Volift

Volift can be used on various areas, including the lips, the nasolabial folds and around the brow line. It is used to compliment the other products and elevate the features.

How many session will I need, and how far apart can I have them?

Each treatment plan will vary depending on each patient therefore you may require one or multiple sessions to complete the full treatment plan discussed at consultation. If you require multiple treatments these will usually be carried out 2-6 weeks apart. Patients can expect to notice the effects as early as 3 weeks and for as long as 18 months after treatment.

Am I a suitable candidate?

Dermal fillers can be used on a wide range of patients, and is primarily used for volume replacement, skin rejuvenation and the reduction of lines and wrinkles.

Who will carry out my treatment?

Pre-treatment information

Treatment will be carried out in a sterile environment. Therefore all make up will be removed if this has not been done so before you arrive.

Please avoid taking aspirin or ibuprofen on the days leading up to your treatment as this can increase the risk of bruising.

Caffeine intake the day of treatment can also increase the risk of bruising.

Post-treatment Information

There is no downtime associated with this treatment, but patients may experience some bruising, swelling and mild discomfort to the treated areas. This will resolve after a few days. Strenuous exercise should be avoided 24-48 hours post treatment to minimise bruising risk. Make up can be worn 2 hours post treatment unless otherwise stated by your practitioner.
